2023 YTD Financial Update

Giving to the General Fund empowers ministry every day. Spending currently exceeds giving by ~\$30,000. Please give generously to ensure we can fully fund our ministry in the final months of 2023. Designated Funds are set aside for large repairs, upgrades to buildings, and investments in missions. As you can see, we are spending our equity from previous years. 

Thanksgiving Offering Sanctuary Restoration

We believe that God is worthy of our worship and that our worship life and space should welcome all people into God's presence! Our 2023 Thanksgiving Offering is dedicated to replacing our failing organ, improving accessibility, and refreshing our worship space. We invite every worshiper to make a one-time special Thanksgiving Offering!

Our sanctuary was built in 1992 and the original organ, carpet, and paint have served well for over 30 years. The organ keys and pedals are now broken, the carpet bears years of wear and tear, and we have persons eager to lead worship who are limited by the steps.







Your gift of \$50-\$50,000+ will help us reach our goal of \$100,000 to fully accomplish this generational refresh to our worship life. Thanksgiving offering priorities:

- Purchase of a new organ (\$57,000).
- Ramp or lift for platform accessibility (\$ 10,000).
- New hearing assist technology (\$1,300).
- Building a functional and aesthetically pleasing technology booth (\$3,500).
- Re-Carpeting of the full sanctuary and chancel with minor platform adjustments (\$15,000).
- Replacement of failed projector.
- Professional Painting of Sanctuary.



South Carroll Food Pantry feeds hungry people. This year, ten percent of our Thanksgiving Offering will be tithed to SCFP.

This year, we serviced -

- 340 people monthly at our Saturday pantry.
- 60 people monthly at our new Crossroads popup pantries.
- 30-40 people weekly as drop-ins.

And we added frozen and refrigerated storage!

Still, eight percent of South Carroll residents remain food insecure.

Each month, need we purchase ~2,800 pounds of food and collect another ~4,500 pounds. Your generous giving will help us purchase food and expand our capabilities overcome transportation and storage limitations to bring the food to our neighbors.

High Impact Gifts

Stocks & Bonds

Do you own stock that has grown in value and that you have held for more than one year? This can become a substantial gift, made at a low net cost to you. You still receive a charitable deduction for the donation of these assets, and it's based on their fair market value on the date of the gift. AND there's a bonus—you avoid all federal capital gains taxes.

Legacy Gift

Do you have a Last Will & Testament? Are you in the process of doing a Will and/or Trust? Have you considered including the Church in your Will? It is quite simple and with the help and guidance of your legal advisor and your family, it can be customized to meet your specific giving needs and legacy goals.

Qualified Retirement Plans

Do you have a qualified retirement plan, such as a 401(k) or an IRA? Are you required to take a required minimum distribution (RMD)? This can be another tax advantage to maximize your giving. By making a direct gift from a qualified plan to a charity, known as a qualified charitable donation (QCD), you do not pay any taxes on that money because it is not included in your adjusted gross income. You may contribute up to \$100,000 each year.

Your gift to the endowment fund can provide sustainable resources to fund ministry and capital improvements for generations to come. By making a gift to the endowment, you can be assured your gift will keep on giving.
